NOTICE OF RACE

The Yacht Club Imperia and the Yacht Club Monaco organizes in collaboration the first edition of Troféo Riviera between the Vele d'Epoca d'Imperia 2-5 September 2021 and the Monaco Classic Week 8-12 September 2021.

ORGANISING AUTHORITY:

The Trofeo Riviera is organized by The Yacht Club Imperia and the Yacht Club de Monaco in conjunction with the Monaco Sailing Federation (FMV) and the Italian Sailing Federation (FIV)

1. RULES

- 1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021 – 2024, the Class Rules, the Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, their annexes and amendments.
- 1.2.** No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3.** Notices to Competitors will be posted on the regatta notice board on line.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising is permitted according to each Class Rules. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1. This race is open tradition boats with a CIM measurement certificate Vintage or Classic.

3.2. Eligible boats may register before the 5th September 2021.

4. FEES

4.1. No entry fee, all the participants present must be invited.

This event is reserved at all participants to the Vele d'Epoca d'Imperia or at the Monaco Classic Week.

5. SCHEDULE

5. REGISTRATION AND MEASUREMENT

At registration, each boat shall present:

(a) A valid measurement certificates declaration.

(b) A valid marine insurance certificate including a valid third-party liability cover for a minimum of 1,5 million Euro per event or the equivalent.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be on line on the official communication system: see the QRCode:



7. THE COURSE

The course to be sailed will be offshore cost race between Imperia to Monaco as per Sailing Instruction.

8. PENALTY SYSTEMS

8.1. The Race Committee may announce the numbers of the boats that have broken starting rules via marine VHF channel 74. Failure to announce OCS over the VHF will be no grounds for redress.

8.2. OCS yachts will not be disqualified but will receive a 5% time penalty on real time. Boats OCS may not return to the start

9. SCORING

The classification will be established in corrected time for each category (Epoque and Classic) into account the theoretical distance of each course.

The corrected time will be calculated according to the C.I.M. Rules 2021-2024 and their modifications.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1.** Support/Coach boats must get accreditation from the Registration Office, leaving complete contacts.
- 10.2.** Support boats must be available for boat & people rescue at any time.

11. OTHER PROHIBITED ACTIONS

- 11.1.** Careening by any means for the purpose of cleaning or inspecting the hull is prohibited during the regatta.
- 11.2.** Underwater breathing apparatus, plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used between Monday 06th September 2021 at 12.00 noon and the end of the regatta. The hull may be cleaned at any time by swimming (outside of the harbour) or keelhauling using ropes or cloth.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 12.1.** Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio or other data transmissions while racing nor receive radio or data communication not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 12.2.** It is the intent of the Organising Authority and Race Committee to use marine VHF radios Channel 72 to communicate with the fleet when outside of Monaco's Marina on VHF Channel 14.

13. PRIZES

- 13.1.** Prize-giving will take place in the Yacht Club de Monaco.
- 13.2.** Prizes will be awarded to the first three (3) boats in each Class Vintage and Classic in compensated time. A prize will be awarded to the first boat overall in real time

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 14.1.** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organising authority shall not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 14.2.** All competitors will also be required to sign a Competitor Liability Waiver form, to be completed at registration.

15. MEDIA RIGHTS

All participants give absolute right and permission to the organisers and event sponsors to use, publish, broadcast or otherwise distribute for promotional, advertising or any other purpose, any images and sound recorded during the event of persons and boats free of any charge.

All participants agree to waive their copyright claims to photographs taken of them during the event, and their right to have any recourse against the organisers for the use made of these photographs.

16. BERTH

Only to the yachts invited to the Monaco Classic Week will be offered a berth in the YCM Marina
